NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The World Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)

1.2 (SP) Australian Sailing Special Regulation Part 2 Off the Beach Boats will apply.

2. ADVERTISING

Advertising will be restricted to Category A.

3. ELIGIBILITY & ENTRY

3.1 Open of Season Regatta is open to all boats of off-the-beach dinghy and catamaran classes.

3.4 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry at <https://kbsc.com.au/open-of-season/> prior to midnight 4th September 2020. Payment of entry fee can be made online at time of entry or during registration between 10am-1130am on 5th September.

3.5 Entrants shall be members of a Club affiliated with Australian Sailing

3.6 Entrants into the QLD Impulse and QLD Arrow State titles are required to be current members of their respective state Class associations.

Entries will be accepted in the following divisions

Division 1 – Monohulls (excluding Impulses)

Division 2 – Catamarans (including entrants in Qld Arrow State Titles)

Division 3 – Intermediates – Australian Sailing Yardstick >120

Division 4 – Juniors- Optimists, Sabots and Open Bics

Division 5 – Impulses (QLD impulse State Titles)

4. FEES

KBSC MEMBERS

For members of Keppel Bay Sailing Club the fees are as follows and cover entry into the Open of Season Regatta and the KBSC Club Racing Season 2020-21

Division 1, 2 & 3 Boats, Per Season \$ 65.00

Division 4 Boats, Per Season \$ 35.00

Division 5 Boats (KBSC Impulse Sailors) \$75

Covers entry into KBSC Club Racing Season

& entry into QLD Impulse State Titles

NON- MEMBERS (VISITORS)

Divisions 1,2,3 & 4 - \$30 per boat

Division 5 (Qld Impulse state title entrants) – \$40

6. MEASUREMENTS

Measurement is not required, but each boat shall submit proof of holding a valid measurement or rating certificate which complies with class rules.

7. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Sailing Instructions will be at Registration on Saturday 5th September.

8. REGATTA SITE

The regatta site will be as shown in illustration 'A' attached.

9. RACING AREA

The racing area will be as shown in illustration 'A' attached.

10. COURSES

The course shall be as described in the Sailing Instructions.

11. SCORING

- 11.1 The low point scoring system as in Appendix A of the RRS will be used.
- 11.2 Australian Sailing Yardsticks will be used
- 11.3 A total of five (5) races will be scheduled. Two (2) races are required to constitute a series.
- 11.4 When fewer than three (3) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 11.5 When four (4) to five (5) races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12. RADIO COMMUNICATIONS

A boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all boats.

13. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded for:

Open of Season Regatta

1st, 2nd and 3rd in Divisions 1,2,3 &4

QLD Impulse State Titles at the discretion of the QLD Impulse association

1st, 2nd & 3rd

QLD Arrow State Titles at the discretion of the Qld Arrow association

1st, 2nd & 3rd

14. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15.INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10 million per event or the equivalent.
