From July 1st 2021, the legal requirements for volunteer clubs, like KBSC, to adhere to more specific and possibly increased obligations toward Child Protection and Code of Conduct, comes into force. KBSC is currently updating its Child Protection Policy and will have the new updated policy very soon.

Please note that a Queensland Blue Card is required for any members, volunteers, contractors and employees who may be involved in the activities or supervision of persons under the age of 18 years.
