Smaller Lighter Boats

For those with smaller boats Optis, Sabots, Lasers and Impulses. Please reverse your trailer onto the carpark near access number 3 (see attached site map). The bollards are quite close together and you will need to lift your boat over. Once over the bollards, wheel your boat on its dolly down to the beach. The sand is quite soft, so you'll need good wide tyres on your dolly if you want to use this access. Some Arrow sailors are also planning to use this access. Conrad will be there to give you a hand.

Larger Boats

We have limited access to the Mulambin Beach with a narrow one-way track. This track requires a 4WD vehicle. We would prefer to manage this process, rather than have individuals driving on to the beach, meeting halfway down the track and creating chaos.

We are providing vehicles (Tractor and Ranger) that will take your boat and road trailer down on to the beach. You will then be able to take your boat off the trailer and put it in the designated rigging area.

When you arrive, please park on the western side of the road (see attached site map) then take your trailer off the car. One of our vehicles will pick up your boat and trailer and take it to the beach.

Drop off times 8am to 10.30am. There will be traffic supervisors there to help if you have any questions. Reminder that briefing is 11.30am.

After presentations on Sunday, the vehicles will tow your boats back up to the main road.

The beach site will have full security from 6pm Saturday night to 7am Sunday.

Beach Access #4

Beach Access #4 is ideal for walking, but the path isn't wide enough for boats. Parking is available, <u>not</u> suitable for cars with trailers. Do <u>not</u> park across the yellow access gates.
