This course aims to teach instructors how to deliver the first three courses of the Dinghy Program including being able to deliver Tackers, Start Sailing 1, Start Sailing 2 and Better Sailing. Participants will learn and practise effective techniques for theory and practical instructing with continuous feedback and support.

PRE- REQUISITES:

- 16 years old and water confident
- Comply with the State/Territory legislation including, but not only, child protection laws
- Hold the level of competence in skills being taught
- Hold a current Australian HLTAID003/011 Provide First Aid Certificate (or higher)
- Hold a current maritime licence, or state equivalent
- Hold an Australian Sailing Powerboat Handling certificate
- Complete The Australian Sailing Instructor General Principles
