They have been practicing new boat handling skills such as, 2 handed sheeting, controlled gybes, slowing down and stopping, sailing backwards and even a bit of gunwale walking and capsized races at the end of the session.

Last week we began sailing around a triangle course, learning how to tack upwind, focusing on a smooth bottom mark rounding.

In the lead up to Saturday's Green Fleet race day, this week we will be learning about start sequences, and putting it all together in some mini practice races.

# Youth Survey

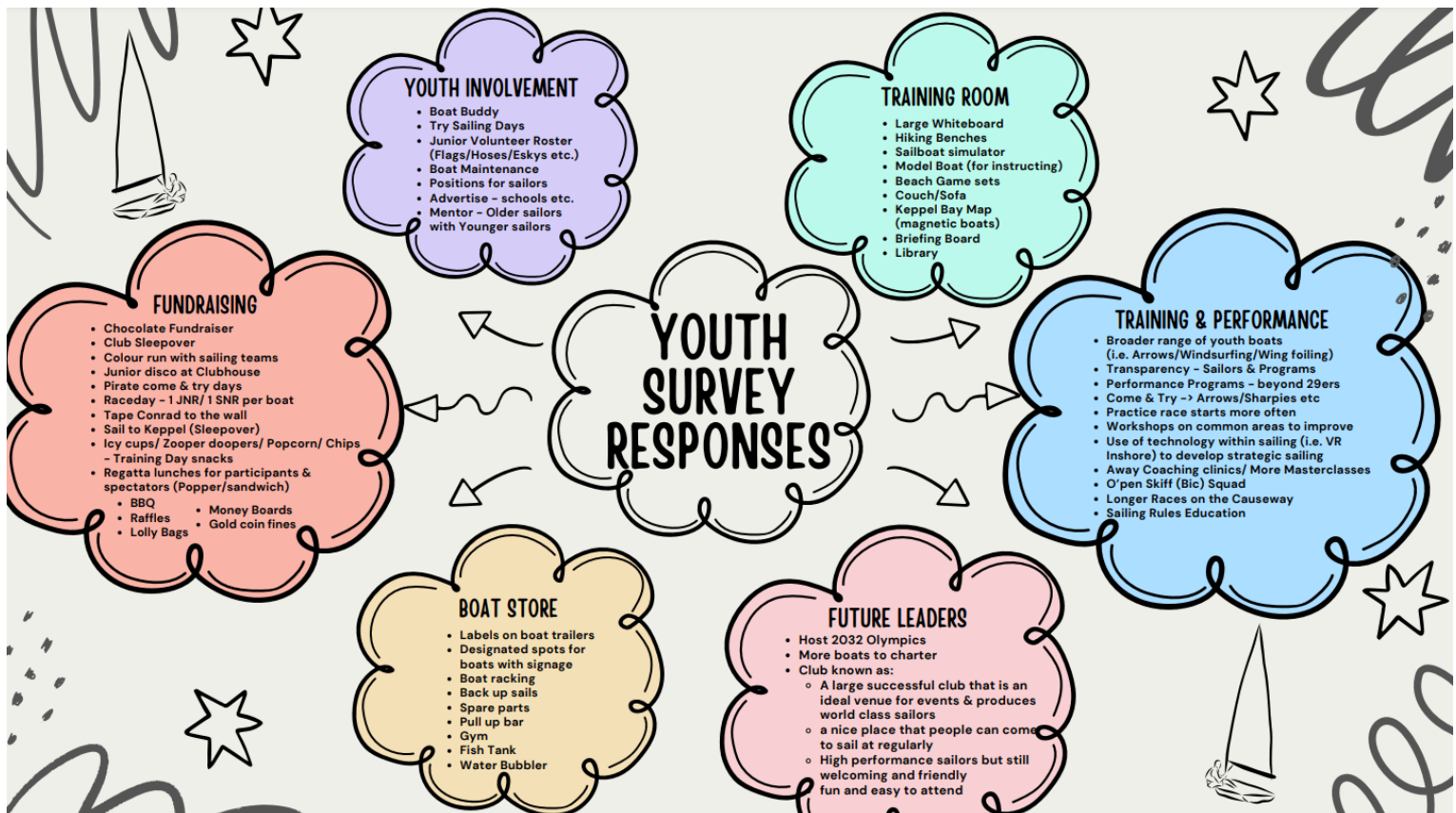
We would like to say a big thank you to all our Junior and Youth Sailors that completed our Youth Survey.
