Division 3 - Intermediates



More training and racing opportunities for the Feva fleet are planned for the new year, with plenty of momentum building already. Watch this space!






At the start of November, Australian Sailing had two fantastic sessions at Cairns Yacht Club with 10 incredible women and girls diving into the world of officiating in sailing!


