Open Skiff Nationals

The 2026 Open Skiff Nationals were hosted by Manly Yacht Club in Sydney, where our sailors produced some fantastic results despite incredibly challenging and constantly shifting conditions. The breeze seemed to come from almost every direction except west, with mid-race shifts ranging from barely noticeable to a dramatic 25 knots, and gusts climbing even higher. Add in very choppy seas and close to 80 boats racing simultaneously, and it made for a truly demanding championship.

Both the Gold and Silver fleets sailed the same course, with a slightly shorter track for the Silver fleet. Gold fleet sailors faced the additional challenge of crossing through or sailing around the entire Silver fleet in every race—an excellent test of boat handling, situational awareness, and confidence in heavy traffic. Our sailors rose to the occasion, significantly sharpening their skills in crowded race situations.


