1 Rules

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the current *Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS)*, except as any of these are changed by the Sailing Instructions.
- 1.2. The Australian Sailing Special Regulations Part 2.

2 Eligibility and Entry

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all off the beach dinghies and catamarans. AS yardsticks will apply to all divisions.
- 2.2. Eligible boats may enter online at <https://www.revolutionise.com.au/kbsc/events/295373> by 10.00pm on Friday 12th June 2026. The one entry enters boats into both the KBSC Womens and Girls Regatta 2026.
- 2.3. Heats 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 will be sailed in the following Divisions:
 - Division 1** – Open Monohulls
 - Division 2** – Open Catamarans
 - Division 3** – Intermediates – Australian Sailing Yardstick >115 (e.g. ILCA 4, ILCA 6, Corsairs with or without spinnakers, Flying 11)
 - Division 4** – Juniors- Optimists, Sabots and Open Bics
 - Division 5** – Green fleet

6 Measurements

Measurement is not required but each boat shall, if asked submit proof of holding a valid measurement or rating certificate.

7 Sailing Instructions

The sailing instructions will be available by 09.00am on Saturday 13th June at the Regatta Office Keppel Bay Sailing Club.

8 Regatta Site

The regatta site is the Keppel Bay Sailing Club, Anzac Parade Yeppoon QLD.

9 Racing Area

The racing area will be as shown in illustration 'A' attached.

10 Courses

The course shall be as described in the sailing instructions.

11 Scoring

The Low Point scoring system, Appendix A will apply. 6 races are scheduled, of which 3 races shall be completed to constitute a series.

Each boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. She may discard her worst score if 4 or more races are completed. The lowest series score wins.

Results will be calculated using the 2025-26 AS Yardstick handicapping system.

12 Radio Communications

A boat shall neither make radio transmission while racing nor receive radio communication not available to all boats.

13 Prizes

Prizes will be awarded to the boats finishing 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each division for the regatta.

14 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 3, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury, or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

15 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 AUD per incident or the equivalent. Insurance details shall be supplied upon registration
